Lesson 18

Jesus and the Blind Man

Today's Story:

Today our story is about Jesus and a man that had been blind all of his life. As Jesus and his disciples passed a blind man, the disciples wondered why this man was born blind. They asked, "Who sinned, the man or his parents that he was born blind?" But Jesus told them that it wasn't the man *or* his parents who sinned, but the man was blind so that Jesus could heal him and the wonderful works and glory of God could be made known.
