*Moses & Pharaoh*

## Today's Story:

In today's story an Egyptian king, called Pharaoh, turned the Israelite people into slaves and treated very cruelly. God heard the cries of his people and sent Moses to rescue them. In the desert, God appeared to Moses and spoke to him from a burning bush. God told Moses to lead the people out of Egypt and away from the cruel Pharaoh. He told Moses to tell Pharaoh, "LET MY PEOPLE GO!" But Pharaoh had a hard heart and would not let the Israelites leave Egypt. God sent many warnings for Pharaoh to repent, but he still would not listen to Moses. Then God told Moses that each Israelite family was to put the blood of a lamb over their doorposts so that they would be safe on the night that the angel of death passed over the homes of Egypt. And they were safe! This night is called the Passover.

Pharaoh finally let God's people leave but he chased them all the way to the Red Sea. God did a mighty act and parted the water so that the Israelite people walked across on dry land. But Pharaoh and his army, who were chasing the Israelites, were drowned in the sea. The Israelites were safe!

During this time, God gave Moses and the people the Ten Commandments. These commandments were rules on how to love God and live according to His ways. However, some of the people rejected God's ways and would NOT follow the commandments. Sadly the people could not yet enter into the land that God had promised them.
