*Kingdom Life Lesson 22:*

*The Servant King*

## Today's Story:

Our story today is about **servicing** God.

Jesus and his disciples were gathered for their last supper together before Jesus was crucified. After supper, Jesus got up and started washing the disciples' feet.

The disciples were really shocked because washing feet was the work of a servant. But Jesus wasn't a servant, he was the Forever King and Lord of All!

So why did Jesus, who was God and Forever King, do the work of a servant? Jesus was teaching the disciples that those who want to be great in the Kingdom of God must serve others.

This is why we call the Kingdom of God **the upside-down Kingdom**. It is different from other kingdoms where those with the most power are the most important.

Jesus is the **Servant King** who set an example for us to follow. Jesus wants us to be more like him and love and serve others.

When we serve others, we are also serving God. Those who serve others are the **greatest** in the upside-down Kingdom of God.
