

OPTION 1 (Full lesson) PROPS

KINGDOM LIFE: LESSON 25 – JONAH AND THE BIG FISH

The following props are for use only with the full Storyboard Lesson (Option 1).

For the Condensed Lesson (Option 2) - see the Condensed Lesson Plan & Poster.

Materials needed:

Essential:	Optional:
Colour printer (or take to print shop)	Stick-on Velcro to secure symbols to storyboard
Letter size card stock for printing (4 sheets)	Acrylic model paint for peg dolls
Scissors, stapler	Small paint brushes for painting peg dolls
Peg dolls: 3 male (in addition to existing dolls)	Clear polyurethane varnish for peg dolls
1 Blue and 1 tan coloured poster (22x28 inch)	Green and brown yarn or fabric if not painting dolls
Box to hold all the props for the Jonah story	
Glue stick or double sided tape (recommended)	
Green felt leftover from making storyboard	

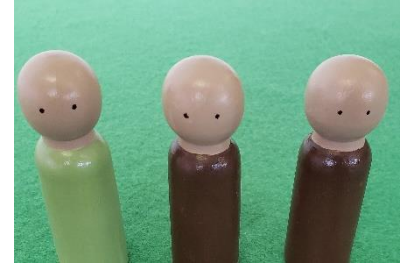
Instructions for storyboard props:

1. Print out pg. 3 - 6 of this document in colour on letter size card stock.
2. Cut out the symbols and props. (Write the lesson number on the back of the symbols.)
3. **Making the story mat:**
Place tan poster on top of the blue poster and slide apart lengthways until the combined length is approx. 43 inches. Cut out a shoreline from the tan poster so it looks approximately like the picture on the next page. Glue the dark Nineveh picture in place on the tan poster as shown in picture.
4. **Making the boat:**
Cut along all the thick lines. Fold along all the dotted lines and use double sided tape or glue to attach the flaps to the sides of the boat.
5. **Making the fish:**
Fold along the bottom of the fish on each side so the white part forms a base. Then fold up the fish-shaped sides and staple together at the top. The fish will have a triangular hollow space inside it that can hold the Jonah peg doll. See picture on next page.
6. Fold the flap under the wave to make it stand upright.
7. Keep all the props for the Jonah story in a box and pull them out one by one as you tell the story.

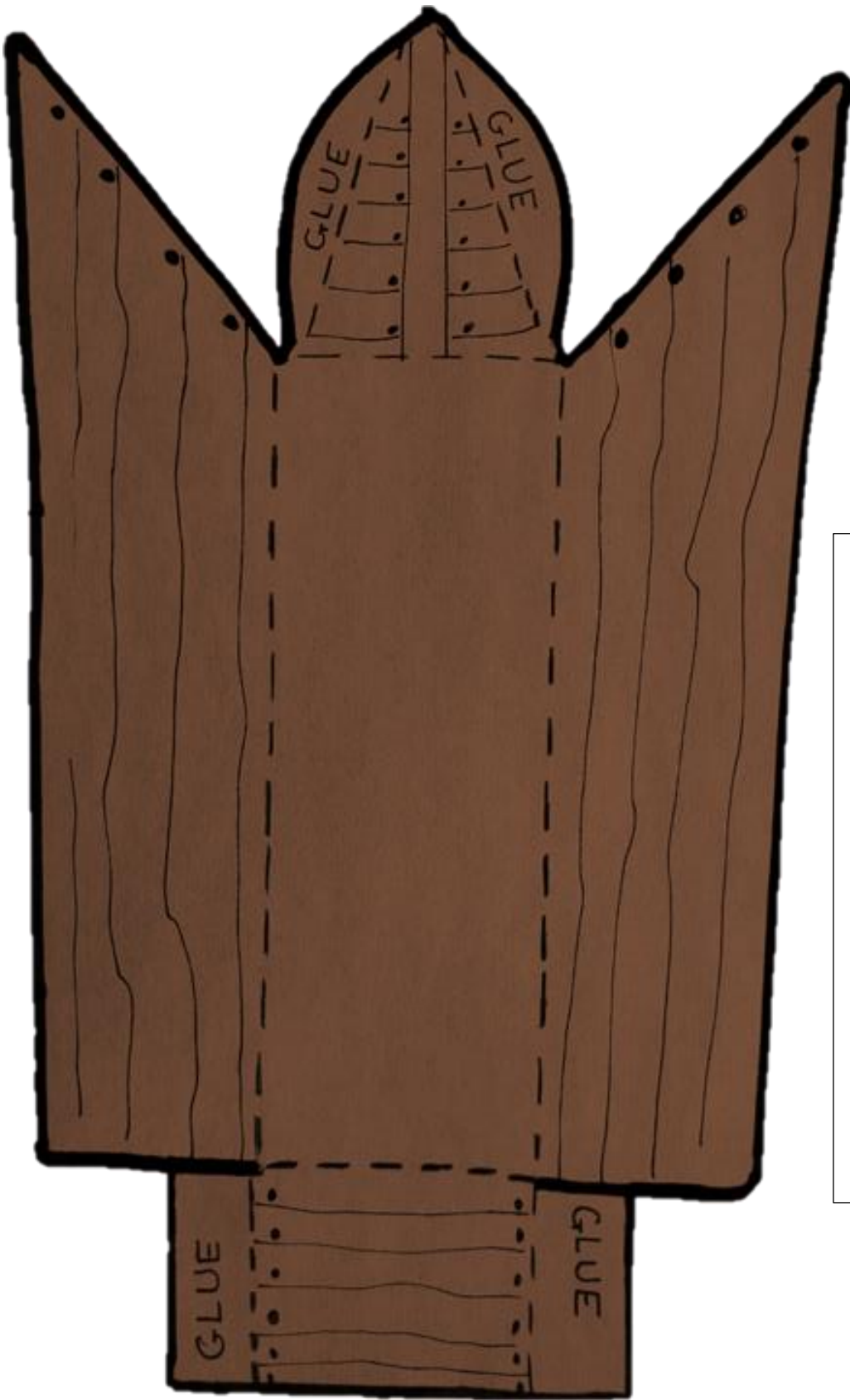
8. Cut 13 circles (approx. 3.5 inches wide) from the green felt that was left over from making the storyboard. Attach the unit title (Spreading the Kingdom) to one of the felt circles with Velcro.
9. For this lesson you will use the 9 peg dolls around the Trinity, as well as the male doll from lesson 4. You will also need 3 additional male peg dolls. See point #5 for instructions.

10. Making the peg dolls:

Essential:	Optional:
Purchase three male peg dolls	Paint the peg dolls. See instructions in lesson 1 props document.
If you are not painting peg dolls, attach green and brown yarn or fabric as a belt around the dolls to distinguish Jonah (green) from the sailors (brown)	Use a black felt pen if you wish to add eyes. Adding a coat of varnish over the paint makes it more durable.



This is how the storymat should look (seen from the children's perspective)

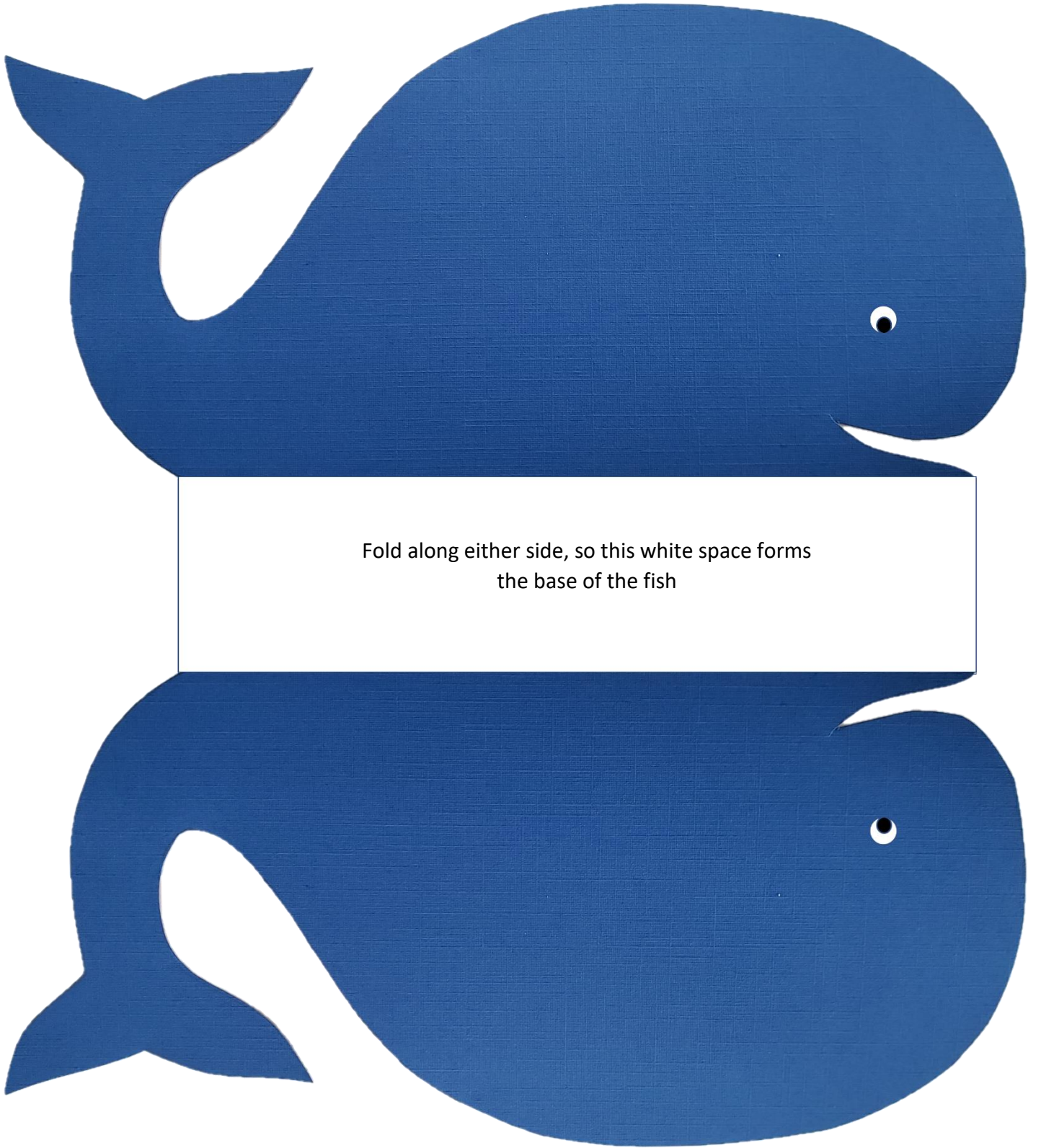

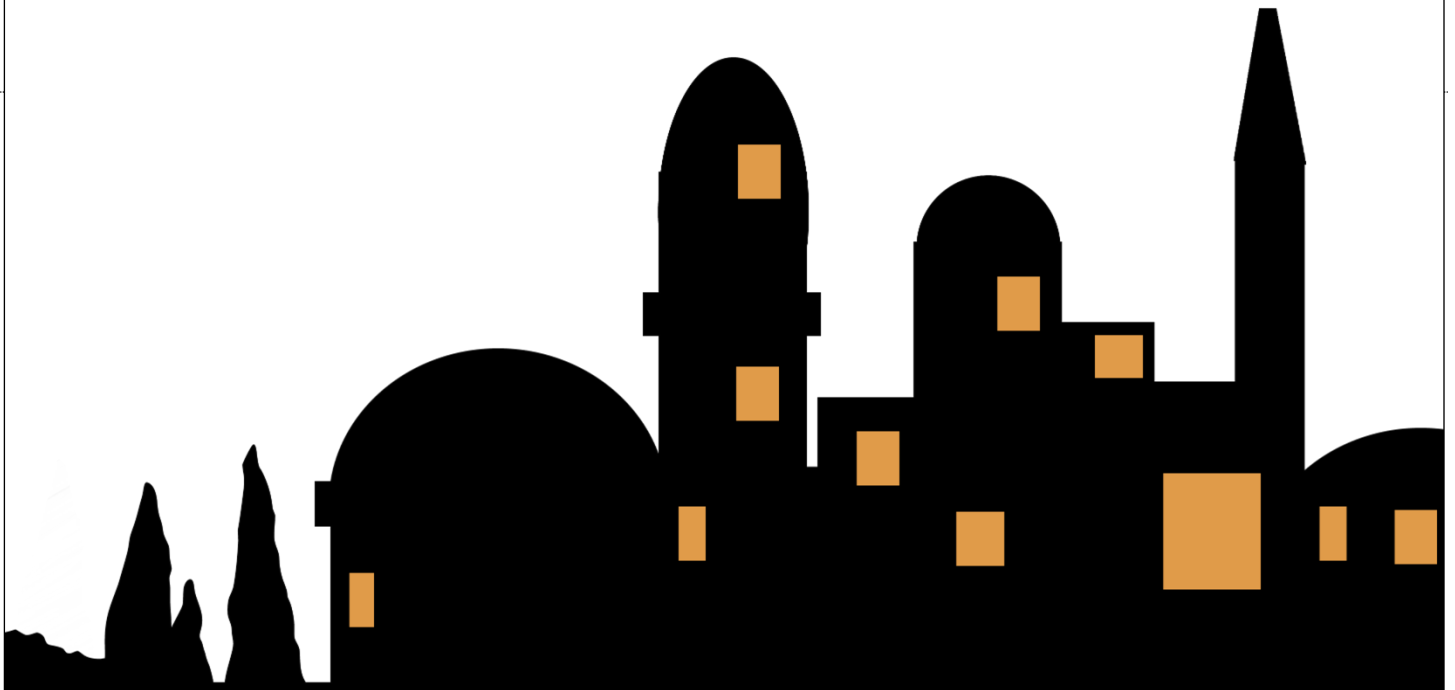
