Kingdom Life Lesson 5

The God Who Reveals Himself

Today's Story:

Today's lesson is about **knowing God**. God is Spirit – invisible to human eyes... so how do we know what he is like?

We can know what God is like because he has **revealed** himself to us! He has shown us who he is. God has revealed himself to us in three main ways: through Creation, through the Bible and through Jesus. We heard about the first two today.

The universe that God created is very, very big! That teaches us that God is even greater – he is the glorious King over everything!

The Bible is God's Word to us. It is where he tells us who he is and what he is like. In the Bible we read about God's mighty acts through history, and we learn that **God is a TRINITY** – Three in one (Father, Son and Holy Spirit). God is also:

Our **CREATOR** - God created everything that exists. He is the source of all life.

ALMIGHTY – God is all powerful, all knowing and everywhere present.

ETERNAL – God has no beginning or end. Nobody created God, he always existed.

HOLY - There is nobody else like God. He is above all, and he is glorious! God is more pure, beautiful, and good than anything in the universe. He is so pure and good that sin cannot come near him. Just like the sun is so hot that it would burn you up before you could get close to it, so sinful people cannot come into God's holy presence. That is why Jesus had to die for our sin - to make us pure and able to enter into God's holy presence.

LOVE - All love flows out from God. The love between the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit is so strong and powerful that it flows out from them to us and enables us to love God and one another. God loves us so much that he sent his son Jesus to die for our sins so we can receive and enjoy his love.

God the **Father** is the 1st person of the Trinity. He is Jesus' Father, and he is also our Father because of what Jesus has done for us. Our heavenly Father loves us perfectly and will always be there for us.
