

OPTION 1 (Full lesson) PROPS

KINGDOM LIFE: LESSON 5 – THE GOD WHO REVEALS HIMSELF

The following props are for use only with the full Storyboard Lesson (Option 1).

For the Condensed Lesson (Option 2) - see the Condensed Lesson Plan & Poster.

Materials needed:

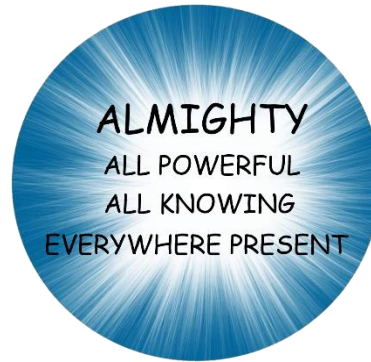
Essential:	Optional:
Colour printer (or take to print shop)	Stick-on Velcro to secure golden circle to storyboard
Letter size card stock for printing (12 sheets)	White sticky tac to attach small symbols to the golden circle
Scissors	
Gold coloured card, reflective or sparkly - min. 10.5 x10.5 inches. (12x12 inch sheets for scrapbooking work well.)	
A wall, poster or flannelgraph to attach bible verse cards to	Make a flannelgraph (recommended) from a 22x28 posterboard, covered in white or green felt

Instructions for storyboard props:

1. Print out pages 2-13 of this document in colour on letter size card stock.
2. Keep the following pages whole, without cutting out the symbols:
 - a. Large teaching aids with larger symbols (creator, almighty, eternal, holy, love, father)
 - b. Trinity poster on the final page
3. Cut out the remaining symbols and Bible verse cards. (Write the lesson number on the back of the symbols and cards. If using flannelgraph, add Velcro or felt on the back of the Bible verse cards.)
4. Cut out a circle that is 10.5" in diameter from the golden card. Or use a double layer of reflective and sparkly gold card like we did (see photo in lesson plan). **Optional:** Attach a few small pieces of stick-on Velcro under the golden circle and unit title to help them stay in place on the storyboard felt.

Instructions for other lesson props:

1. **Optional:** How to make the flannelgraph: Cover the 22x28 posterboard in white or green felt. Attach the felt to the posterboard using double sided tape or glue. We recommend making this flannelgraph, as this can be used for every lesson that calls for a display poster. You will need small pieces of Velcro or felt on the back of cards or symbols to attach them to the flannelgraph. Alternatively, the teaching aids can be displayed on an empty wall using sticky tac.

Verse #5:

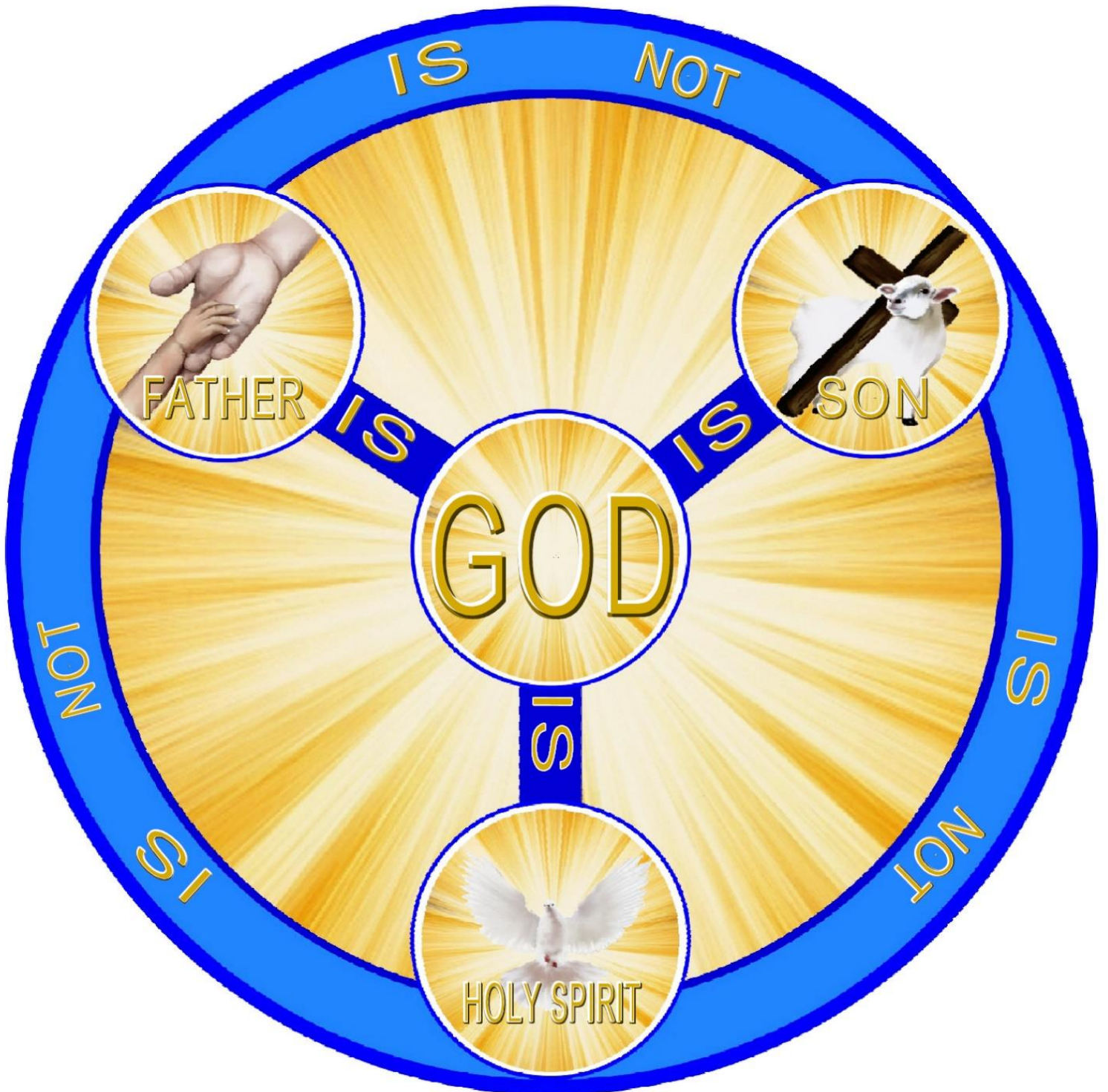
“God is **love.**”
