Kingdom Life Lesson 6:

The Image of the Invisible God

Today's Story:

Today we learned more about **knowing God**.

God has revealed himself to us through Creation and also through the Bible. In the Bible we learn about who God is and about his mighty acts in history.

But God has revealed himself most of all **through Jesus**.

God is a Trinity – three in one. The Trinity has always existed – the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

One day something amazing happened! The 2nd person of the Trinity, God the Son, was born into the world as a baby, a human being, and was given the name Jesus!

When the Father sent his Son to earth to become the man, Jesus, God was revealed to us in a new way. **Jesus became the physical image of the invisible God**. Now we could see God and touch him!

All the things that are true about God, are also true about Jesus. **He is Creator, Almighty, Eternal, Holy, and Love**.

Jesus is also:

- **Immanuel** – that means “God with us”. God himself came down from Heaven and became one of us – what an incredible miracle!
- **Fully man and fully God** – Jesus got his human nature from his mother Mary, and his divine nature through the Holy Spirit.
- Our **Saviour** – Jesus is the Lamb of God, the perfect, sinless sacrifice for our sins that the lamb sacrifices in the Old Testament pointed forward to. When Jesus died on the cross, he paid for our sins once and for all.
- The **Light of the World** who leads us away from the darkness of sin and death and into the light of God’s life.
- Our **Forever King and Lord of All**, who will one day return to reign on the earth.
