

OPTION 1 (Full lesson) PROPS

KINGDOM LIFE: SPOTLIGHT ON PRAYER 1 – PRAYER OF CONFESSION

The following props are for use only with the full Storyboard Lesson (Option 1).

For the Condensed Lesson (Option 2) - see the Condensed Lesson Plan & Poster.

Materials needed:

Essential:	Optional:
Colour printer (or take to print shop)	
Letter size card stock for printing (2 sheets)	
Scissors	
Jesus peg doll from lesson 3, and male peg doll from lesson 4	
Small piece of gold ribbon to use as crown for Jesus peg doll	
White sticky tac to fasten crown to Jesus peg doll	Stick-on Velcro to secure symbols to storyboard
Brown pipe cleaners for making crosses	OR order small wooden holding crosses from Bethlehem (available on Amazon)

Instructions for storyboard props:

1. Print out pages 2-3 of this document in colour on letter size card stock.
2. Cut out the symbols on page 2. Keep page 3 as a whole poster. (Write the lesson number on the back of the symbols.)
3. Make pipe cleaner crosses according to instructions on page 2. Alternatively, order small wooden holding crosses from Bethlehem (available on Amazon).
4. Cut gold ribbon to form a crown around the head of Jesus peg doll, overlapping a little at the back. Use white sticky tac to fasten overlapping ends and to secure onto peg doll head.
5. **Optional:** Attach a small piece of stick-on Velcro under the unit title and prayer hands symbols to help them stay in place on the storyboard felt. Do not put Velcro under the other word cards as they will be removed after this lesson.

Making pipe cleaner crosses:

1. Fold pipe cleaner in half.
2. Approx. 1 inch down from the bend, fold pipe cleaner out to the side about 1 inch.
3. Fold pipe cleaner back on itself to extend about 1 inch on the other side to form the cross bar.
4. Fold back towards the middle and fold the end around the middle to secure the middle corners together.
5. Fold the bottom part up so there is a short end to secure around the middle. The finished cross should look like this:
