# Kingdom News

*Kingdom Life – Prayer 6:*

*Asking God*

## Today's Story:

Today's lesson was about **talking with God** in prayer.

Jesus taught us to pray. In previous lessons we have talked about different types of prayer, like adoring God in worship, confessing our sins, and giving thanks to God. Today we talked about "asking" God for things. Another word for "asking" is "**Supplication**". Supplication means **to ask God for something for ourselves or for others**.

Sometimes we worry about things, but God wants us to **talk to him** about **everything** in prayer, anytime and anywhere. We can tell God about it and ask him to help us.

God's **answers** to our prayers can be "yes", "no" or "wait". One thing we can be sure of is that God always **hears** our prayers, even when the answer is different than what we asked him for. We can **trust** that God's will is always best because he is perfectly wise and loving.

We can pray alone, and we can **pray together**. We can pray with our family at home, and with our church family. Praying with somebody is another way of caring for them. We don't have to pray out loud for God to hear us, but we pray out loud so others can hear our prayer and be encouraged.

When we pray, we can use prayers that are **written out** for us, like the Lord's Prayer. We can also pray using our **own words**. It does not have to be a long prayer; it can just be short and simple.
